From 3th - 10th August 2013 the Eissportclub Oberstdorf Ev and ShorttrackOnline.info are organising for the second time a summer camp and international short track competition for the Oberstdorf Shorttrack Trophy. This event is the follow up of the Trophee Léon Quaglia, which was held for many years in Chamonix. We do hope to continue this tradition with a week of training on ice and inline roller training on an excellent inline track. Besides the short track competition there will also be a running and inline competition. And Oberstdorf is a perfect region for cycling and mountain bike activities. For this sporting event Short track skaters from all over the world are invited to come to Oberstdorf Germany.

Participation

The participation in the summer camp and in the competition for the Oberstdorf Shorttrack Trophy is open to novices, Juniors, Seniors and Masters. All skaters must be a member of a club affiliated to their National Skating Association (member of the ISU) in their respective country and have a licence and insurance for the season 2013-2014.

Recreational Participants

Parents, brothers, sisters and friends can also take part in the off-ice events (if time/place available) in a recreational classification at their own risk and responsibility.

Helpdesk

During the summer camp a helpdesk will be available for information etc. in the office of the Eis-sportclub Oberstdorf Ev. The helpdesk is situated next door to the entrance of the ice rink. Opening times will be published later.

Support of parents

Parents are requested to help as much as possible with the events and activities around the competitions like transport to activities, operating water stations, road Marshalls, etc.

News-bulletins

A daily bulletin will be handed out with News and information of the summer camp and all activities.

Meals at ice rink-restaurant.

The restaurant of the ice rink will prepare a special daily menu for everyone attending the Summer Camp. The price will be 10,50 Euros for each meal, lunch or dinner. The meals should be pre-booked at the help desk at least 1 day in advance.

Oberstdorf

Oberstdorf is a little mountain village in the south of Germany situated at the foot of the Alps. Famous for its beautiful surroundings, many mountain bike and cycling tracks, a perfect inline track and an Olympic Sports Centre with 3 top quality ice rinks. As Oberstdorf is also an Olympic training centre everybody and everything is focussed on serving athletes. Most famous are the ski-jump slope with its annual New Year competition, the International Figure Skating competition for the Nebelhorn Trophy and the Figure skating show which is held every year at Christmas and is televised around the world. www.oberstdorf.de/en/

Organizer: The summer camp and short track competition are organized by the Eissportclub Oberstdorf Ev and by the volunteers of Shorttrackonline.info with the support of the Sport Office of the City of Oberstdorf.

Venue: The Shorttrack competition will take place on the ice rink of Oberstdorf which is 60x30 meter and has safety padding of international standard.

Regulations: The shorttrack competition will be held in accordance with the 2012 ISU Regulations and relevant ISU Communications.

Categories:

Novices	on the 1st of July 2013 under 13
Junior C	on the 1st of July 2013 13 or 14
Junior B	on the 1st of July 2013 15 or 16
Junior A/Senior	on the 1st of July 2013 17 or older
Masters	on the 1st of July 2013 40 or older

Distances: will be decided based on the number of skaters and the available time for the competition.

Classification: The skaters will be classified according to the number of points awarded in the finals only. There will be an overall individual classification over all distances. In case of ties, the results of the longer distance will decide between the skaters.

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded for the Overall classification of the running, the biathlon and the short track competition for the first three skaters in each category.

Liability: In accordance with the ISU rules, the organizers accept no liability for injury or damage sustained by competitors and/or officials during all training sessions, events of the summer camp and the short track competition.

The summercamp, competition programme and announcement are tentative and if necessary subject to change.

Please pay attention to the following remarks

- for safety and organisational matters, all participants must be international confirmed skaters. During the training sessions the equipment of all skaters must be according to the ISU rules. For inline skating helmet, gloves and kneepads are obligatory.
- organizers will provide a schedule for on ice training sessions based on the level of the skaters and available trainers. It is not allowed to change between the on ice sessions without permission of the organisers.
- before the 1st session the safety padding must be put on the ice by all skaters. After the last training session the safety padding must be taken off the ice by all skaters
- although clubs have to provide their own trainers the organisers will coordinate this and support with additional trainers. In order to make the right level of training groups it could be necessary that trainers have to work together and teams are mixed. If a club has no trainer available it must be mentioned on the entry form.
- during the short track competition all skaters will stay on the ice for one more race (after their own race) in order to be a track steward in the one race after they have competed themselves.
- It is the intention of the summercamp that skaters join for the whole week and all events. Skaters who cannot join the whole week can, in case of available places, compete in the short track competition only. The entry fee will then be 25,00 euro including the Closing Dinner and award presentation on Saturday evening.

Entry

Entry can only be done by club-representatives (with approval of their respective ISU-member), or National Association, through the website www.shorttrackonline.info at the latest on 15 July 2013. Don't forget to mention your mobile phone number, date and time of arrival and place to stay in Oberstdorf.

The entry-fee for the summer camp including the Oberstdorf Shorttrack Trophy and the Closing Dinner on Saturday-evening will be 110,00 euro per person. For late entries after 16 July 2013 the entry-fee will be 120,00 euro. These costs must be paid in cash at the check-in desk on Saturday.

All clubs who entered skaters will receive a confirmation or, in case of the Summer Camp being over subscribed, a cancellation in due time.

For the Closing Dinner extra tickets can be bought for parents and supporters for a price of 10,00 euro.
